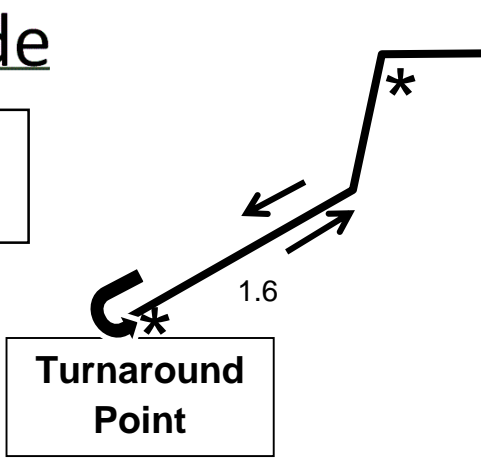

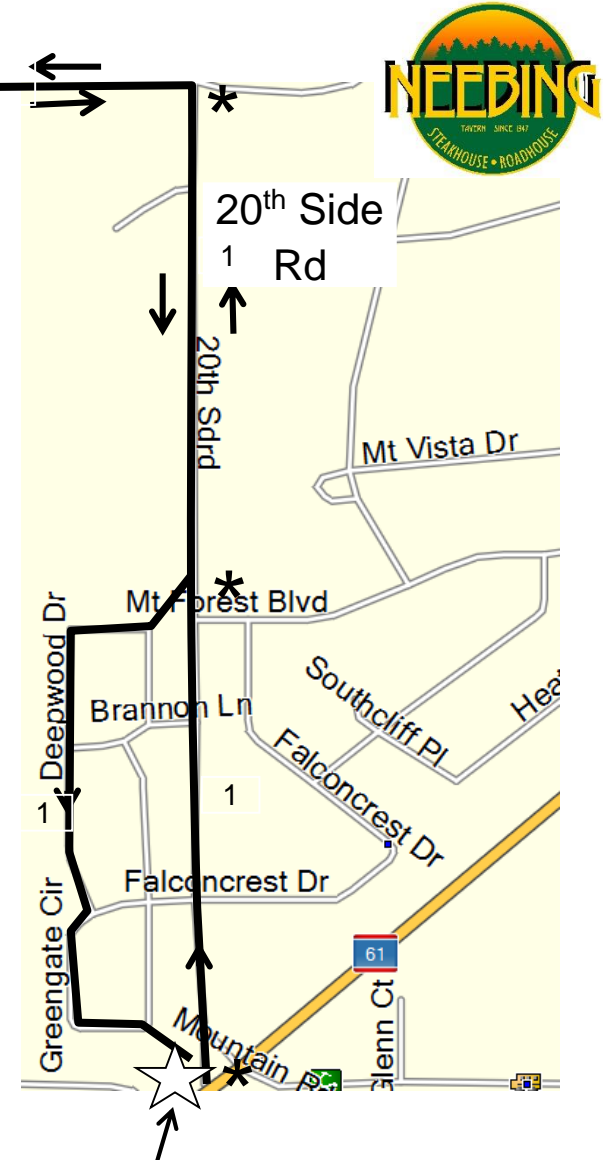
**Short Route**

## DIRECTIONS

- Start at Neebing Roadhouse parking lot
- TL and head north on 20th Side Rd
- TL to West Riverdale Rd
- Turn around at (or before) Candy Mt. Rd
- TR to 20th Side Rd
- TR to path after Kamview parking lot
- TR to Deepwood Drive
- Stay to right until you see a bikepath
- TR to bikepath
- End in parking lot at Neebing Roadhouse

TR – Turn Right  
TL – Turn Left

**Neebing Roadhouse**



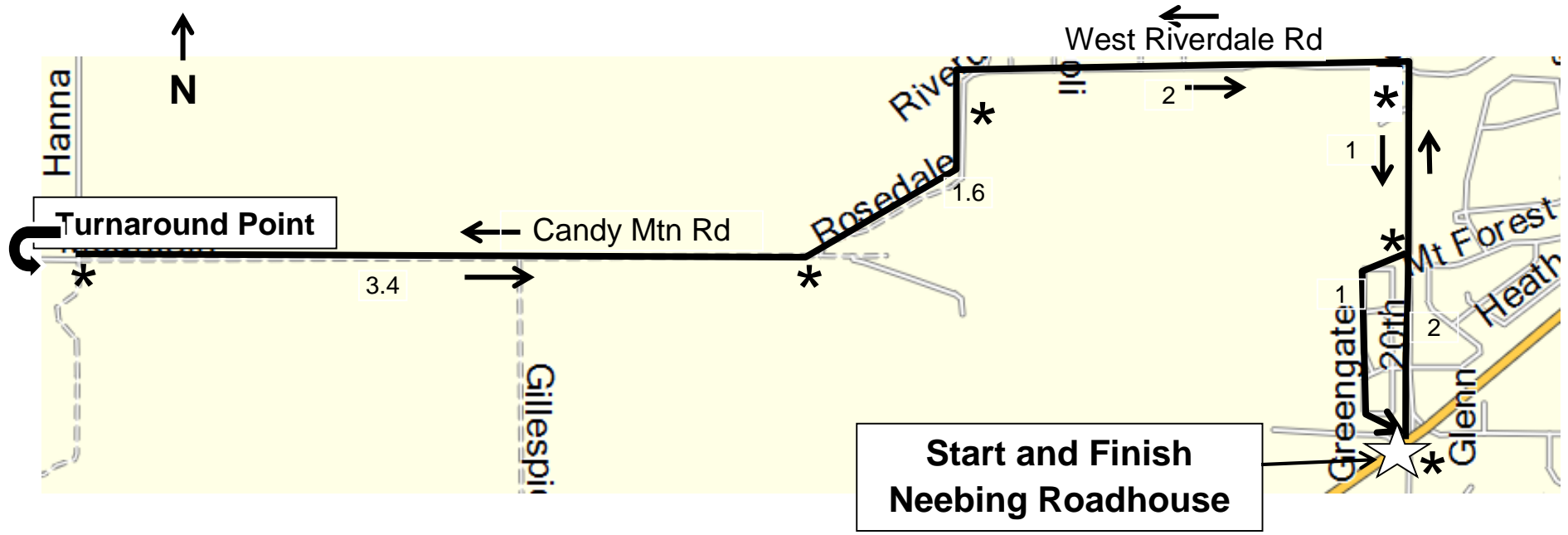

**18km**<sub>2020</sub>

**DIRECTIONS**  
Start at Neebing Roadhouse parking lot  
TL and head north on 20th Side Rd  
TL to West Riverdale Rd  
TR to Candy Mtn Rd  
Turn Around at Hanna Rd  
TL to West Riverdale Rd  
TR to 20th Side Rd  
TR to path after Kamview parking lot  
TR to Deepwood Drive  
Stay to right until you see a bikepath  
TR to bikepath  
End in parking lot at Neebing Roadhouse

TR – Turn Right  
TL – Turn Left

**Long Route**  
**53km**<sub>2020</sub>

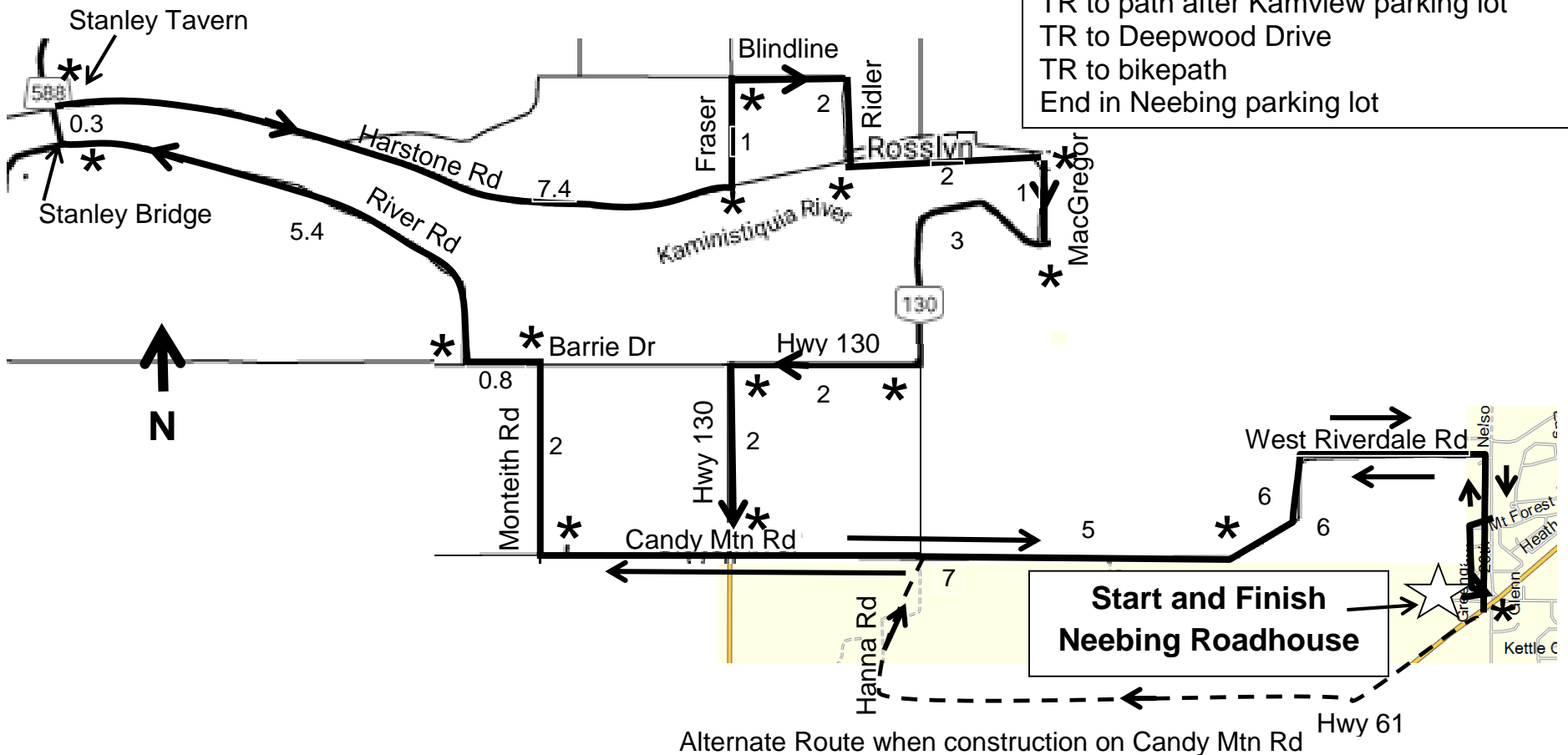
## DIRECTIONS (first part)

Start at Neebing Roadhouse parking lot  
 TL and head north on 20th Side Rd  
 TL to West Riverdale Rd  
 TR to Candy Mtn Rd  
 TR to Monteith Rd  
 TL to Barrie Rd  
 TR to River Rd  
 TR to Hwy 588 (cross Kam River)  
 TR to Harstone Rd (at Stanley Tavern)

TR – Turn Right  
 TL – Turn Left

## DIRECTIONS (second part)

TL to Fraser Rd  
 TR to Blindline/Ridler Rd  
 TL to Rosslyn Rd  
 TR to MacGregor St  
 TR to Hwy 130 (cross Kam River)  
 TR to stay on Hwy 130 (at Hanna Rd)  
 TL to stay on Hwy 130 (at Barrie Rd)  
 TL to Candy Mtn Rd  
 TL to West Riverdale Rd  
 TR to 20th Side Rd  
 TR to path after Kamview parking lot  
 TR to Deepwood Drive  
 TR to bikepath  
 End in Neebing parking lot

## Our arrows

You will see white temporary arrows on the road along the route. They are usually in a cluster of 4. The last arrow has a number which indicates the approximate distance to the next turn.

There 3 types of arrows.

- 1) Arrows with turns
- 2) Arrows showing straight
- 3) Arrows showing a turn around point for the 10 and 20 routes
